Princeton Joint Unified School District offers a mathematics sequence of classes for seventh through eleventh grade students that is determined by student grade level.

7<sup>th</sup> Grade: Math 7 8<sup>th</sup> Grade: Math 8

9<sup>th</sup> Grade: Integrated Math I 10<sup>th</sup> Grade: Integrated Math II 11<sup>th</sup> Grade: Integrated Math III

12<sup>th</sup> Grade: Independent Study Options – UC Scout Online Classes (Trigonometry, Calculus,

Statistics)

No students are held back from this progression. If an additional math support class is available on the master schedule in a given year, students may take an additional period of mathematics support based on teacher recommendation from class grades and assessments.

As required by statute, an annual report will be made to the Princeton Joint Unified School District Board of Education detailing that students are being promoted through the mathematics sequence of courses according to grade.
